CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Dawn Marie Nelson of West Hartford, Connecticut has applied for licensure to practice occupational therapy by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 376a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Dawn Marie Nelson hereby admits and acknowledges that:

1. On or about December 19, 1985 she was issued a temporary permit to practice occupational therapy;
2. Said temporary permit expired on or about March 31, 1986;
3. She continued to practice after such date without any permit or license;
4. By her action described in paragraph 3. above, she committed an act which failed to conform to the accepted standards of occupational therapists and she is subject to licensure denial under Public Act 86-365 §1(a)(6)(E).

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to §19a-17 of the Connecticut General Statutes and Public Act 86-365, Dawn Marie Nelson hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. That she waives the right to a hearing on the merits of this matter.

2. That she is granted a license to practice occupational therapy.
3. That she is hereby reprimanded.
4. That she understands that notice of this Consent Order is a matter of public record.
5. That she understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Commissioner of the Department of Health Services or his duly appointed agent arising out of a subsequent series of facts (1) in which her compliance with this same order is at issue, or (2) in which her compliance with §20-74g of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
6. That this Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, that said order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive her of any rights that she may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
9. That she understands that she has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Dawn Marie Nelson, have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.
