
VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT NOT TO RENEW OR REINSTATE LICENSE

Joel Spirtas, President of Spirco Services, Inc., a corporation organized under the laws of the State of Missouri, being duly sworn, deposes and says:


1. I am over the age of majority and understand the obligations of an oath.
2. I make this affidavit on the basis of personal knowledge.
3. Spirco Services, Inc. is licensed by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") to practice as an asbestos contractor. Spirco Services, Inc. holds license number 000093, which expired on December 31, 2000.
4. Spirco Services, Inc. hereby voluntarily agrees not to renew or reinstate its license to practice as an asbestos contractor in the State of Connecticut.
5. Spirco Services, Inc. understands and agrees that if it seeks a new license or to reinstate its license at any time in the future, the allegations contained in Petition Number 2001-0111-053-001 shall be deemed true. Spirco Services, Inc. further understands that any such application must be made to the Department which shall have absolute discretion as to whether said license shall be issued or reinstated and, if so, whether said license shall be subject to conditions.
6. Spirco Services, Inc. hereby waives any right to a hearing it may have regarding any request that its license be reinstated or that a new license be issued and also waive any right that it may have to appeal or otherwise challenge the disposition of any such request.
7. Spirco Services, Inc. understands and agrees that this affidavit and the case file in Petition Number 2001-0111-053-001 are public documents, and Spirco Services, Inc. is executing this affidavit in settlement of the allegations contained in the above-referenced petition.
8. Spirco Services, Inc. understands that this agreement not to renew or reinstate its license is a reportable event and is public information.
9. Spirco Services, Inc. understands that this document has no effect unless and until it is executed by the Department; and that, upon execution, the Department will dismiss Petition No. 2001-0111-053-001.


10. Spirco Services, Inc. understands that it has the right to consult with an attorney prior to signing this affidavit.





**MOTION TO WITHDRAW STATEMENT OF CHARGES**


Comes now the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") and hereby moves the Hearing Officer (hereinafter "the Board") for an Order granting this Motion to Withdraw. As grounds for this Motion, the Department states that on June 8, 2001, respondent signed a Voluntary Agreement Not to Renew or Reinstate License. A copy of respondent's Agreement is attached hereto marked as Attachment "A." The Department has accepted respondent's Agreement.

Respondent has voluntarily given up its right to practice as an asbestos contractor in Connecticut with the Department's approval. For this reason, the Department believes that continued prosecution of this case is unnecessary, and that it is in the interests of justice and administrative economy to terminate these proceedings at this time.
