VOLUNTARY AGREEMENT NOT TO RENEW OR REINSTATE LICENSE


David Harrison, authorized representative for New Fairfield Funeral Home, being duly sworn, deposes and says:


1. I am over the age of majority and understand the obligations of an oath.
2. I make this affidavit on the basis of personal knowledge.
3. New Fairfield Funeral Home was issued an inspection certificate by the Department of Public Health (hereinafter "the Department") to conduct a funeral service business, under certificate number 000307. Such inspection certificate lapsed on June 30, 2000.
4. New Fairfield Funeral Home hereby voluntarily agrees not to renew or reinstate its inspection certificate to conduct a funeral service business in the State of Connecticut.
5. I understand and agree that if New Fairfield Funeral Home seeks a new inspection certificate or to reinstate its inspection certificate at any time in the future, the allegations contained in Petition Number 2002-0305-030-009 shall be deemed true. I further understand that any such application must be made to the Department which shall have absolute discretion as to whether said certificate shall be issued or reinstated and, if so, whether said certificate shall be subject to conditions.
6. New Fairfield Funeral Home hereby waives any right to a hearing it may have regarding any request that its inspection certificate be reinstated or that a new inspection certificate be issued and also waives any right that it may have to appeal or otherwise challenge the disposition of any such request.
7. New Fairfield Funeral Home agrees that this affidavit and the case file in Petition Number 2002-0305-030-009 are public documents, and this affidavit is executed in settlement of the allegations contained in the above-referenced petition.
8. New Fairfield Funeral Home agrees to cooperate with the Department in any investigation involving possible violation(s) of statutes governing the conduct of embalmer/funeral directors and/or the operation of a funeral service business or the care and/or disposal of human remains, in the event that any additional complaints are received by the Department

- 9. This agreement not to renew or reinstate its inspection certificate is a reportable event and is public information.
- 10. I understand that this document has no effect unless and until it is executed by the Department; and that, upon execution, the Department will dismiss Petition No. 2002-0305-030-009.
- 11. It is understood that New Fairfield Funeral Home has the right to consult with an attorney prior to executing this affidavit.
