CONSENT ORDER

WHEREAS, Oscar Maldonado, S.W., of Windsor, Connecticut, has been issued Certification Number 002425, to practice as a Certified Independent Social Worker by the Department of Health Services pursuant to Chapter 383b of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended; and

WHEREAS, Oscar Maldonado, S.W., hereinafter referred to as the Respondent, hereby admits as follows:

1. Between 1985 and 1992 Respondent was employed as a psychiatric social worker at Hartford Hospital, in Hartford, Connecticut.
2. As part of his employment, Respondent provided individual psychotherapy and counseling to patients.
3. In 1985 and 1986 Respondent engaged in sexual relationship with a female patient for whom he was providing individual counseling, and with whom he had a therapeutic relationship.
4. In 1988 Respondent initiated and engaged in a sexual relationship with another female patient for whom he was providing individual counseling, and which whom he had a therapeutic relationship.

5. By his actions in 1.-4. above Respondent violated the provisions of Section 20-195p of the General Statutes of Connecticut by failing to conform to the accepted standards of his profession.

6. Respondent is not presently practicing as a Certified Independent Social Worker in Connecticut, but is employed by the State Department of Corrections as a social worker at this time.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to Section 19a-17 and Section 20-195p of the General Statutes of Connecticut, Oscar Maldonado hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:


1. Respondent waives his right to a hearing on the merits of this matter;
2. Respondent's Certification to practice as a Certified Independent Social Worker in Connecticut is hereby revoked;
3. Respondent understands that this Consent Order may be considered as evidence of the above admitted violations in any proceeding before the Commissioner of Health Services in which his compliance with Section 20-195p of the General Statutes of Connecticut, as amended, is at issue.
4. This Consent Order and terms set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or in any forum. Further, this Consent order is not subject to appeal or review under the provisions of Chapters 54 or 368a of the General Statutes of Connecticut, provided that this stipulation shall not deprive Respondent of any other rights that he may have under the laws of the State of Connecticut or of the United States.
5. This Consent Order is a revocable offer of settlement which may be modified by mutual agreement or withdrawn by the Department of Health Services at any time prior to its being executed by the last signatory.

6. This Consent Order is effective the first day of the next month after which the seal of the last signatory is fixed to this document.
7. Respondent permits a representative of the Public Health Hearing Office of the Division of Medical Quality Assurance, Connecticut Department of Health Services to present this Consent Order and the factual basis for said Consent Order to the Commissioner of Health Services or her agent. He understands that the Commissioner has complete and final discretion as to whether or not an executed Consent Order is approved or granted. Respondent further agrees that the pre-hearing review form signed by him is incorporated by reference into this Consent Order.
8. Respondent has consulted with an attorney prior to signing this document.

I, Oscar Maldonado, S.W., have read the above Consent Order, and I agree and admit to the terms and allegations set forth therein. I further declare the execution of this Consent Order to be my free act and deed.


