CONSENT DECREE

**IN THE MATTER OF: Phil A. Lagana, EMT, Cert. #95-765
OEMS Case #95-009**

WHEREAS, Phil Lagana has been trained in accordance with certain standards of practice for Emergency Medical Services established by the training curriculum which has been adopted and endorsed by the State of Connecticut; and,

WHEREAS, Phil Lagana of 5 Pumpkin Stem, Norwalk, Connecticut 06851 has been certified by the Office of Emergency Medical Services to perform as a Emergency Medical Technician, Certification #95-765 and,

WHEREAS, an OEMS investigation has determined that on or about July 1, 1995, you represented yourself as an Emergency Medical Technician-Intermediate and attempted to start an intravenous line on a patient, and,

WHEREAS, such failure is a violation of Section 19a-179-9 (f) of the Regulations of Connecticut State Agencies.

NOW THEREFORE, pursuant to the Connecticut General Statutes, Section 19a-180, Phil Lagana hereby stipulates and agrees to the following:

1. Phil Lagana knowingly and voluntarily waives any right to any administrative hearing or appeal he may have with regard to the above-captioned violations.
2. This Consent Decree, containing specific stipulations, will constitute the sole action taken by the Office of Emergency Medical Services with respect to Phil Lagana, pertaining to the aforementioned violations.
3. Phil Lagana agrees to immediately and voluntarily surrender his Emergency Medical Technician certification for a period of one (1) year.
4. Phil Lagana understands that this Consent Decree shall remain in his certification file and may be considered as evidence of previous misconduct in any future proceeding before the Department in which his failure to comply with applicable statutes and regulations is alleged.
5. This Consent Decree is effective the first day of the next month after it is accepted and ordered by the Office of Emergency Medical Services.
6. This Consent Decree and the terms and conditions set forth herein are not subject to reconsideration, collateral attack or judicial review under any form or


